Purpose: Removal of wood from fallen trees

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. This permit is valid for removal of downed and/or fallen trees in area designated by the Park Manager or his/her designee ONLY. The cutting of live trees is STRICTLY PROHIBITED; violators will be prosecuted.
2. This permit is granted with the understanding that the wood collected is for personal home consumption and will not be used for commercial purposes.
3. The permittee must abide by any instruction given by Long Island State Park Police or park employees. For the purpose of identification, this permit must be prominently displayed on the front dashboard of permittee's vehicle while in park for collection of wood.
4. Permits will be valid for vehicle bearing license plate number specified on permit ONLY.
5. New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation - Long Island Region reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time.
6. This permit is valid at the above-specified park from 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM ONLY on the day specified above.
7. Permittee must have permit validated and pay a \$10.00 deposit (CASH ONLY) at the park office on the day the permit is used. Deposit will be returned upon surrender of the permit to the park office, not later than 4:00PM ON THE SAME DAY. Failure to surrender permit will result in automatic forfeiture of deposit. There will be no refunds of deposit for revoked permits.
8. Failure to have permit validated or any other infraction of the Wood Removal Permit special conditions will result in immediate revocation of the permit and exclusion of violators from all future Wood Removal Permits.
9. This permit is granted on condition that the permittee shall be responsible for any damage to park property or facilities, which may result from the cutting or removal of such wood. The said permittee assumes all risks and shall hold harmless and indemnify the State of New York, New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, their officers, agents, and employees for any and all claims for injury or death arising out of an accident to himself or others resulting from activities under this permit.
10. Permittee is required to indicate acceptance of the conditions of this permit by signing below. Permit is not valid until signed by permittee and validated by Park Manager or his/her designee.
